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## **Booth Rules and Regulations**

1. The deadline for submitting an application and fee is **Friday June 10,2011**. You will be notified by mail after all applications have been processed.
2. In an earnest attempt to provide only American Indian made arts/crafts the committee will not allow any imported or non-Indian items to be sold.
3. **Sage, sweet grass, cedar ceremonial pipes, bowl and stems made of pipestone may not be sold due to their ceremonial purpose and significance.**
4. We reserve the right to ask for removal of any merchandise which is not listed, on the approved application.
5. Arts/craft booths will be 10'x 10'.  
**There is absolutely no booth sharing.**
6. There will be no electrical outlets provided for this event.
7. Vendors will be notified as to what time they may set up in the approval letter.
8. All animals must be kept on a leash and out of the arena area. You are responsible for your animals.
